## Variety: Anderson (NY 9295)

### Fruit characteristics (# of years of data)

<b>Fruit type:</b>	Light sweet
<b>Skin color:</b>	High blush (90%)
<b>Flesh color:</b>	Cream yellow
<b>Percent cracking:</b>	1.8 (9 yrs)
<b>Firmness:</b>	303 (9 yrs)
<b>Size (g):</b>	6.3 (9 yrs)
<b>Soluble Solids:</b>	17.7 (9 yrs)
<b>Flavor:</b>	Above Avg. (8 yrs)
<b>Pit shape:</b>	Spherical



### Tree characteristics (# of years of data)

<b>Yield:</b>	Heavy (4 yrs)
<b>Bloom Group:</b>	Mid (11 yrs)
<b>Harvest timing:</b>	Mid (8 yrs)
<b>Tree vigor:</b>	Strong (9 yrs)
<b>Noted disease incidence:</b>	Trace amount of bacterial canker in 4 out of 9 years
<b>Noted cold damage:</b>	Low severity (9 yrs)

**Summary remarks:** A large, stem-on cocktail cherry with long, thick stems. Well suited for stem-on mechanical harvest. Named in honor of Dr. Robert Anderson, Cornell University.
