Summary remarks: Impressively large, heart shaped fruit, with good flavor but less firmness than other fresh market varieties. Ripens mid-season, but often is picked earlier, especially by pick your own customers due to remarkable size. Moderately susceptible to rain cracking, and tree winter hardiness may be marginal in some years. Self-infertile, in pollen group I (S₁S₂), with a mid to late bloom season.
