**Summary remarks:** Trees are productive, cold hardy and well-adapted to the growing conditions of eastern North America, with low susceptibility to cherry leaf spot and bacterial canker. Fruit are moderately tolerant of rain. Self-fertile, with a mid-to-late bloom season.

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
